

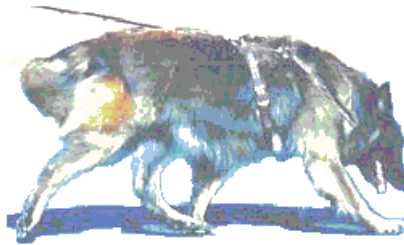

- Tracking harness and long line for your dog, if you have them.
- Tracking articles (odd socks, a glove — any leather, cloth, metal, or soft plastic articles about the size of a glove or wallet).
- A variety of REALLY great soft treats that your dog loves.
- Water for you and your dog.
- QUESTIONS that you want answered. Issues you want help with.

We'll be providing some tracking flags, copies of the AKC tracking regulations, and a resource list for you to take home. . Fee \$20 for CBTF members.
